Please pray for us as we have moved already to this area, and we have been working hard making contacts in the area. We look forward to this new opportunity and ask for your prayers. We had our first Sunday service with 22 in attendance. We praise the Lord for the people that God sent us. One man named Adolfo said with tears in his eyes this was the first time he and his family had ever been in church together. Please pray for Adolfo and his wife Yeimy and their son Jeremy. Their Catholic family members are not happy they are attending, and we ask that you pray for boldness for this young family in the Lord.

Our second Sunday, we had 23 in attendance with a young lady named Iranea saved. Isn't God Wonderful! Please pray for her as she grows spiritually.

We are looking forward to working in this area for many years and seeing the Lord do a great work with the dear people of Atenas.
